MAY TO-DO-LIST

- Apply compost to your gardens
- Make compost
- Collect fallen leaves form mulch
- Planting of deciduous trees and shrubs
- Trim back deadwood on fruit trees and shape slightly
- Plant large container trees while the weather is mild
- Dead head or cut back summer flowering perennials
- Dig up congested perennial clumps, divide and replant
- Foliar feed the orchard and potager
- Side dress vegetables with compost
- Mulch fruit trees
- Remove old fruit and clean up under fruit trees
- Sow winter beneficial bug attracting plants
- Sow seeds for June planting
- Check over orchard for pests and possible disease
